WrapShield SA Self-Adhered System

A self-adhered water-resistive vapor-permeable air barrier sheet membrane system with liquid flashing



WrapShield SA Self-Adhered System is the first water resistive barrier (WRB)/air barrier self-adhered sheet good membrane system to earn a Declare label placing the system at the forefront of the transparency movement.

- To qualify for a Declare label, a building product must either be free of, or declare any harmful Red List chemicals and meet all Appropriate Sourcing Imperatives as determined by the International Living Future Institute.
- WrapShield SA Self-Adhered required no changes to its formulation or material components, because from its inception it was free of harmful ingredients including all Red List Chemicals.
